



#### **UPDATE**

on

#### **BUILDING ISSUES**

Members of your Building Advisory Committee (BAC) met via Zoom on Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. The purpose of this meeting was primarily to discuss a proposal arising from a Divisional lighting audit done earlier in June. The estimated savings and potential long-term improvement in our carbon footprint are extraordinary.

In spite of a few errors in the initial audit data, the committee felt that the project's savings were worth considering and recommended that we move on to the next phase of the proposal in order to access firm details of what the updating of our lighting fixtures and equipment would cost and the energy savings we could realize from the project. Divisional Headquarters have been informed of our interest. Details will be passed along to the members of Ottawa Citadel once they are received.

Another matter was raised concerning the continuing leak in the basement of the Officers' Quarters. It is not clear yet what the source of the leak is but it occurs following rain storms which indicates that it may be the result of a fracture in the concrete wall or a blockage in the drainage tile at the footings. David Holland has contacted a company to address the problem. They have scheduled the work to begin during the last week of August when they will dig down to the weeping tile to assess whether the tile is damaged or whether there is a crack in the foundation.

Although this is not the sort of weather in which we normally talk about snow removal, a contract has been signed with the same company that does our lawn care as well as snow clearing at the Corps. A clause has been included in the new contract clarifying that the snow from the parking lot is to be pushed onto the lawn area at the south side of the building once the island between the two parking lot entrances has been filled.
